Be Prepared



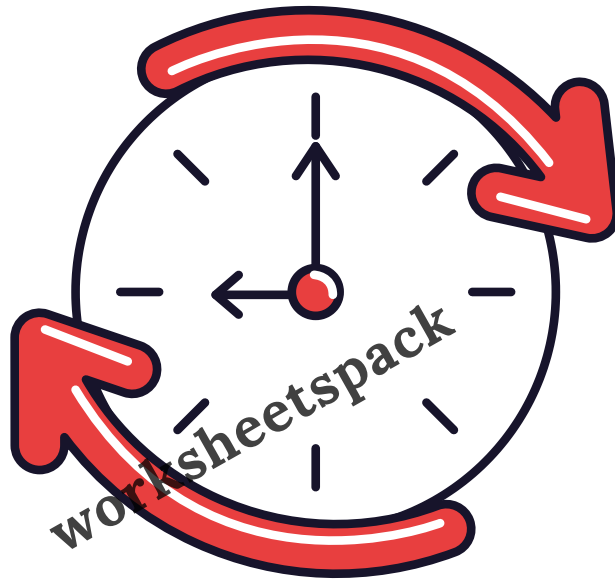
