History Museum: A place to learn about a country's past.

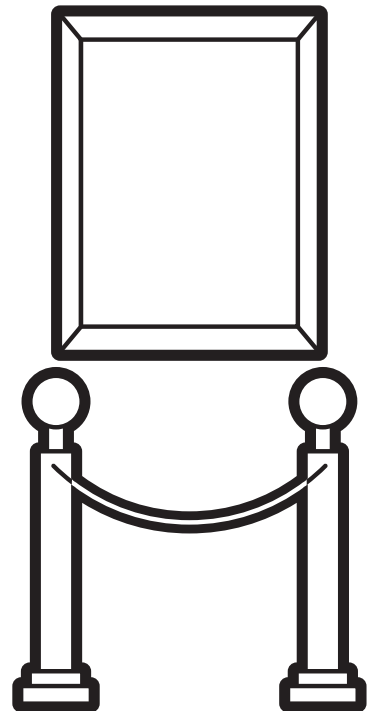
Maritime Museum: Displays marine specimens and artifacts.

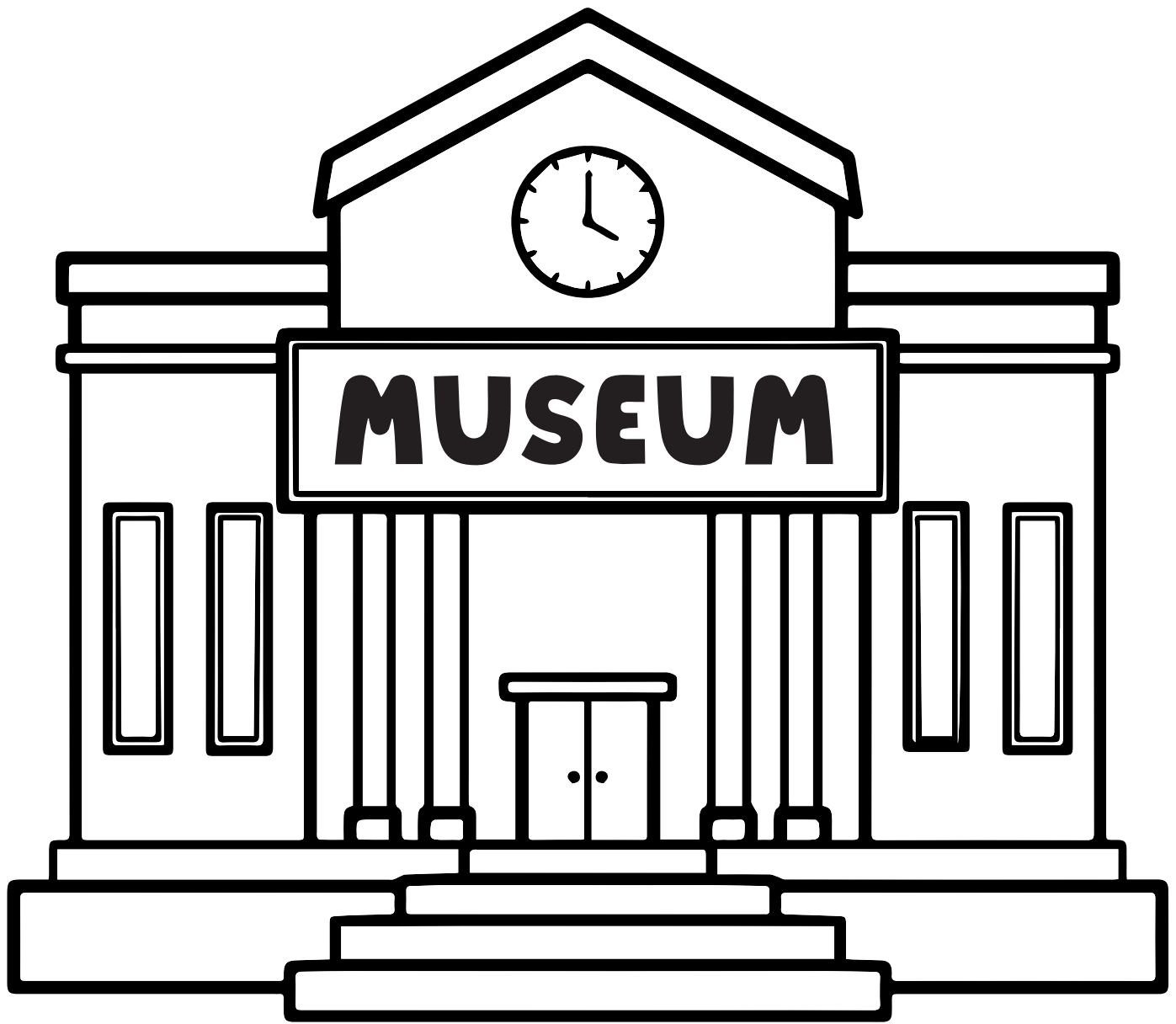
Natural History Museum: Displays specimens from the natural world.
